Definitions

1. In these regulations, a word or expression to which a meaning is assigned in the Act or the Regulations has the same meaning, and unless the context otherwise indicates

"Act" means the Communications Act, 2009 (Act No. 8 of 2009)

Amendment of regulation 1 of the Regulations

- 2. Regulation 1 of the Regulation is amended by-
 - (a) the insertion of the following definition after the definition of "Navigation and radar system services"-

"Network Facilities" means a telecommunications service licence entitling the holder to construct, maintain, own and make available one or more network elements, infrastructure or other facilities that facilitate the provision of telecommunication services, broadcasting services, electronic communications services or application services including content services.

Amendment of regulation 5 of the Regulations

- 3. Regulation 5 of the Regulations is amended by the substitution of sub-regulation (1) with the following sub-regulations:
 - "(1) The following are categories of telecommunications service licences, all of which are technology and service neutral-
 - (a) Individual (Comprehensive telecommunications (ECNS and ECS)); and
 - (b) Class;
 - (i) ECS;
 - (ii) ECNS;
 - (iii) Comprehensive telecommunications service licences (ECNS and ECS);
 - (iv) Non-profit ECNS/ECS; and
 - (v) Network Facilities."
- 4. Regulation 5 (2) of the Regulations is amended by deletion of-
 - "(c) Non-profit ECNS/ECS"

The purpose of the amendment of the proposed Regulations is to developments in the telecommunications industry-

- (a) amend "Non-Profit ECNS/ECS" as a service licence category not requiring a licence to a telecommunications service licence category requiring a service licence awarded by the Authority; and
- (b) create a new telecommunications service licence category namely "network facilities".
