#### REDUCTION IN FIXED AND MOBILE TERMINATION RATES

The Communications Regulatory Authority of Namibia herewith gives notice that, in consultation with the relevant licensees, it has reduced the mobile and fixed termination rates effective from 1 November 2013 as follows:

- |       |                               |          |
|-------|-------------------------------|----------|
| (i)   | Mobile termination rate (MTR) | N\$ 0.20 |
| (ii)  | Fixed termination rate (FTR)  | N\$ 0.20 |
| (iii) | SMS                           | N\$ 0.01 |

Section 2(k) of the Communications Act, 2009 (Act No. 8 of 2009) states that the objects of the Act are "to ensure fair competition and consumer protection in the telecommunications sector." Call termination is a monopoly and overwhelming international evidence exists that cost-based termination rates encourage competition and affordable pricing.

Cost-based termination rates remove market distortions and provide efficient investment incentives. The net effect of fair competition is lower costs of communication, better services and more equitable returns on investment for all operators. It is therefore clear that by lowering termination rates this objective of the Act will be fulfilled.
